ABOUT SCHOOL OF WOMEN'S STUDIES, UTKAL UNIVERSITY

The School of Women's Studies is functioning under Utkal University. It is imparting Master Degree in Women Studies & Ph.D. in Women Studies. It was established in the year 1996 with P.G diploma program and got UGC Recognition as Women Studies Research Center in 1999. As the first state Center for Women's Studies. It is functioning in the thrust areas research, training, teaching and advocacy for women's development in the state of Odisha. Since then, it is continuing as a UGC Center receiving UGC grants and Master degree in SFC mode.

ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, UTKAL UNIVERSITY

The Post-Graduate Department of History was founded on 1st December 1959 at the then Ravenshaw College, Cuttack. It was shifted to Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar in July 1962 when the University moved to its present premises from Cuttack. Ever since the Department is functioning in the Old Arts Block of the University. The founder faculty members of the Department were Prof. M.N. Das, Prof. Prabhat Mukherjee, and Prof. B.C. Ray. Prof. M.N. Das became the first Head of the Department and establishment himself as a famous scholar of Modern Indian History. Prof. Ray and Prof. Mukherjee pursued Regional History, particularly, the History and culture of Odisha and published monumental works. One among the largest Departments of the University, it functions at present as an autonomous Department of Learning and Research. The output of research in the Department, both in the qualitative and quantitative sense, has also got due recognition by the community of scholars and academics all around. The PG Department of History gave way to the formation of a new Department to disseminate the ideas, research and expertise on Orissan Culture and Archaeology and formed the Department of Ancient Indian History, Culture and Archaeology in July 1996. The University hence, has accorded it the status of an autonomous Department since January 1995. The Department has successfully celebrated the Golden Jubilee Year of its foundation during the session 2009-10. The Centre for Ambedkar Studies, sponsored by the UGC under XI plan, was set up at the PG Dept. of History, Utkal University on 2nd May 2007.

CONCEPT NOTE:

Women empowerment is a topic that has been discussed for a long time. A nation that has unfurled its wings and ready to take off, the role of gender and participation comes to forefront that needs to be answered. Empowerment, the catch phrase of the 90's around the world has evolved with time, space and generation. So, the question arises about what is gender empowerment today and if it has a space in this nation that we have envisioned? Is there a space for those who are in the margins, whose voices have been silenced and muffled? Are they empowered to be heard? Have we moved away from victimhood and respected agency? Are we empowered citizens or just subjects of the nation state? We hope to address these and many more issues in these three days of gathering.

The present international seminar has been planned to achieve the following objectives:

- To discuss upon the varieties of female experience range from the ancient world to the modern, from the local to the global, and deal with all corners of the globe.
- To investigate the ways gender interacts with other factors, particularly race and class, to explore the experience of women from the factory floor to the milking parlour to the milliner's shop to reveal the varieties of female experience.
- To look into the history of masculinity and the way men's lives are affected by gender norms are also addressed.
- To exchange experiences in promoting the empowerment of women through different educational programmes, both formal and non-formal;

- To ignite the deliberations for bridging the gap between the regulations and the ground reality of the position of women around the globe.
- To discuss the role of women in inclusive growth and how women empowerment can increase the velocity of inclusive growth, through capacity building.
- To discuss the issues to be tackled to streamline the existing programmes on women empowerment.
